You will find yourself working in Continuous Rounds, and Short Rows. Everything will be clearly marked and stated where/when is to happen. It is very important to pay attention to the instructions and stitch counts as you make this project.

You'll see that I've used my own 3D printed AddOns with this pattern. These are NOT required to make your Jinx Ghost! So please don't let my crazy hold you back!

Lastly, and most important. You are NOT allowed to take this pattern in parts or as a whole and redistribute as your own. Modifications to make other animals from this pattern is NOT allowed. I have sole rights and ownership to this pattern, including and not limited to other animal designs made from this pattern.

You Will Need

- Yarn Weight and Color of your Choosing
- Coorisponding Hook Size
- FiberFil
- Stitch Markers
- 24mm Safety Eyes
- *Optional Items:
 - 3D Printed Witch Hat, and Bow tie.

Stitches to Know

FR - Foundation Ring

SISt - Slip Stitch

Sc- Single Crochet

Dc - Double Crochet

Inc - Increase/Sc 2 in same stitch

Dec - Decrease/Sc 2 stitches together

Ch- Chain

Ch&T - Chain and Turn

SkSt-Skip Stitch

*Special Stitch: Dc8Tog Across 2 Sts: Double Crochet 4 together in 1st stitch, and another Double Crochet 4 together in 2nd stitch. Pull through ALL loops on hook and Chain 1.



- 3. (Sc, Inc) x6 [18]
- 4. Sc, Inc, (Sc 2, Inc) x5, Sc [24]
- 5. (Sc 3, Inc) x6 [30]
- 6. Sc 2, Inc, (Sc 4, Inc) x5, Sc 2 [36]
- 7. (Sc 5, Inc) x6 [42]
- 8. Sc 3, Inc, (Sc 6, Inc) x5, Sc 3 [48]
- 9-14. Sc Around [48] 6 Rounds Total
- 15. Sc 13, Dc8Tog across 2 sts and Ch.1, Sc to end [48]
- Ch. 1 COUNTS as a Stitch*
- 16-18. Sc Around [48] 3 Rounds Total
- 19. Sc 3, Dec, (Sc 6, Dec) x5, Sc 3 [42]
- 20. (Sc 5, Dec) x6 [36]
- 21. Sc 2, Dec, (Sc 4, Dec) x5, Sc 2 [30]
- 22. (Sc 3, Dec) x6 [24]
- 23-25. Sc Around [24] 3 Round Total



- 26. (Sc 3, Inc) x6 [30]
- 27. Sc 2, Inc, (Sc 4, Inc) x5, Sc 2 [36
- 28. (Sc 5, Inc) x6 [42]
- 29-32. Sc Around [42] 4 Rounds Total
- 33. (Sc 5, Dec) x6 [36]
- 34-36. Sc Around [36] 3 Rounds Total
- 37. Sc 2, Dec, (Sc 4, Dec) x5, Sc 2 [30]
- 38. (Sc 3, Dec) x6 [24]
- 39 41. Sc Around [24] 3 Rounds Total
- 42. Sc 4 -STOP-







If using the Safety Bow Tie AddOn, Attach centered with nose between Rounds 24&25.

From here you will start going back and forth between using Short Rows and Continuous Rounds. This is clearly marked, just make sure to pay attention.



Short Rows

- 43. Ch&T, SkSt, Sc 10, Leaving 1 St unworked.
- 44. Ch&T, SkSt, Sc 8, Leaving 1 St unworked.

Continuous Rounds

- 45. Sc 4, SISt 8, Sc 12 [24]
- 46. Sc 4, Dec x4, Sc 12 [20]
- 47. Sc 2, SISt 4, Sc 14 [20]
- 48. Sc 2, Dec x2, Sc 14 [18]
- 49. Sc 2, SISt 4, Sc 12 [18]
- 50. Sc 4 **-STOP-**

Short Rows

- 51. Ch&T, SkSt, Sc 8, Leaving 1 St unworked.
- 52. Ch&T, SkSt, Sc 6, Leaving 1 St unworked.

Continuous Rounds

- 53. Sc 4, SISt 6, Sc 8 [18]
- 54. Sc 4, Dec x3, Sc 8 [15]
- 55. Sc 2, SISt 6, Sc 7 [15]
- 56. Sc 2, Dec x3, Sc 7 [12]
- 57. SISt 6, Sc 6 [12]
- 58. Sc Around [12]
- 59. Dec x3, Sc 6 [9]
- 60. Sc, SISt 4, Sc 4 [9]
- 61. Sc Around [9]
- F/O and Close. Sculpt Around the Eyes if you Desire.
