

Granny Wristlet

US Terms - Beginner Level

You Will Need

- Worsted (4) Yarn -
- 4.5mm Hook
- Bag Base- *Can be crocheted with a Magic Ring of 6, increased evenly by multiples of 6 for 12 rounds.

Terms to Know

SlSt - Slip Stitch

Ch- Chain

SkSt- Skip Stitch

Sc- Single Crochet

Hdc - Half Double Crochet

Dc - Double Crochet

GrCl - Granny Cluster (3 Dc in the same st)

Special Stitches

GrCldec - Granny Cluster Decrease - Work a Dc. Then working in the same space and the next space work a Dc Decrease. Work one more Dc in the same space you finished the Dc Decrease in.

*This allows you to keep the look of the granny clusters, but also gives a nice clean decrease.

Crab Stitch - Also known as the reverse single crochet.

Ch. 1 at the start of each round. Beginning Ch.1 does NOT count as a stitch. Join with SlSt at the end of every round.

To begin, attach yarn to base with a SlSt and Ch. 1.

1.(Sc 2, Inc) x17, Sc 4. [72]

2.(GrCl, Sk2Sts) x24. [24 Clusters]

3-12. GrCl into each gap between previous round clusters.

Repeat round 3 until desired height. I personally do 12 rounds.

13. (GrCl 4, GrCldec) x4.

[20 Clusters] >>>

14-16. GrCl Around. [20 Clusters] - 3 Rounds.

17. Hdc Around. [60]

18. (Dc 4, Ch. 1, SkSt) x11, Dc 2, Ch. 1 *do not SkSt*, Dc 2.

Join to 1st stitch with a Hdc, this acts as a Ch. 1 and sets you to begin into the Ch. Space for the next round. [48 Dc, 13 Ch. Spaces]

19. Hdc around in each St AND Ch. Space. [61]

Optional

20. Crab Stitch around. [61]

Finish off and Weave any ends.

Lastly, you'll want to make a chain the circumference of your bag and weave it through the chain spaces.

Then attach the ends or simply knot them together to create your strap/closure.

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
